A different Worldview

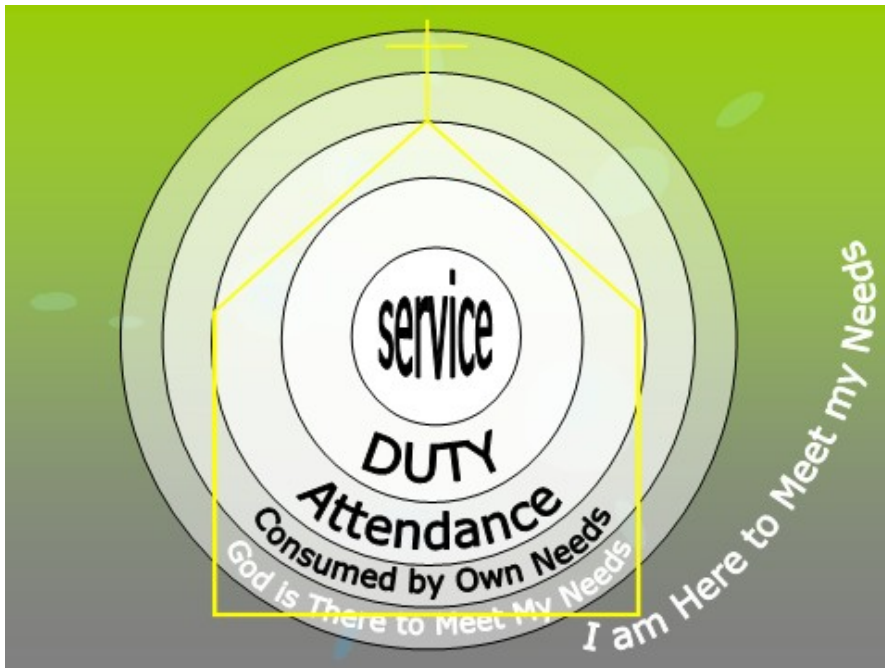
The Christian worldview is somewhat different to the one we naturally drift to. It is different to the one practiced in our workplaces.
